



Ranger-led Programs in March



March 2,9,16,23,30 Saturday van tours-10 am

Participants will be transported by van to the visitor center where they can join the ranger for a 45-minute guided walking tour of the fort ruins or enjoy the site on their own. The van will leave the visitor center at noon. The van and the visitor center are accessible by wheelchairs. Space on this tour is limited to 11 people so reservations are *strongly encouraged*. March 3,10,17,24,31 Sunday guided hikes-10 am

The 1.5 mile, one-way hike to the fort ruins will focus primarily on the chronology of events that led to the establishment of the fort. Participants can return to the parking lot at their leisure. No reservations are necessary for this hike.

For both programs meet a park ranger at 10 am at the Fort Bowie NHS trailhead on Apache Pass Road. All programs are open to both individuals and groups. Participants are encouraged to bring water, a snack or picnic lunch, sun protection, layered clothing, and a camera.
